


## Newsletter

### Science

In our science lessons we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be learning about the types of teeth and their functions. We will also be looking at the human digestive system and food chains.

### PD


In our personal development lessons we will be looking at relationships. We will understand that bodies and feelings can be hurt and develop strategies to solve conflict and disputes.

### Multiplication Tables Check

In Year 4, all children in England take a multiplication tables check where they are tested on 25 different multiplication questions. Throughout the year, pupils will be given opportunities to practise their tables. Please support your child by encouraging them to keep practising them to improve their confidence.

### History

We will be exploring Britain during the Anglo-Saxon, Viking, and Norman eras, focusing on the Battle of Hastings and William the Conqueror's victory. We will be looking at castle design, attack and defence strategies, and the feudal system with Lords, knights, soldiers, and servants.



### Art/DT

During our art lessons, we will be drawing and investigating how artists create their own styles. In DT, we will be learning about the different structures and functions of castles and designing and making our own castle structures.

### Maths

- Place value with numbers up to 10 000.
- Read and write numbers up to 10,000 in numerals and in words.
- Addition and subtraction with numbers up to 10 000.
- Times tables including 3x, 4x, 8x.
